



## Nadcap Testing Requirements

The following requirements apply to *all Nadcap-related work* submitted to Luvak. In order to comply with the requirements of AC7101 and better serve our customers, Luvak requests that our customers include the following information on the paperwork accompanying samples submitted for analysis:

**Authorization:** The material supplier's purchase order number and, in the case of a blanket purchase order, the release number and name of technical contact.

**Identification:** The identification should include the sample number, the heat number and the lot number including other lots represented to tie the laboratory report to the material supplier's records.

**Sample Description:** The sample description should include the quantity, form, and condition of the sample(s). Examples: 1 bar, 3 in O.D.; 2 weld coupons; 6 cast test bars. Condition – As cast/forged, pickled.

**Material Name and Requirements:** The material name should include the following designations:

- a. Material specification including applicable revisions and class to which material is to be evaluated and certified.
- b. Tests to be performed.
- c. Testing specifications if not included in material specification. For example: Test per ASTM E1019 or ASTM E1097.
- d. Common name of material.

If a sample type is unknown, please designate "unknown." If a specification certification is not required, please indicate so.
